Non-surgical ridge augmentation, minimal-invasive and maximum esthetics – is this possible?

"Minimally invasive dentistry" - the mantra in modern dentistry - must obviously conflict with implant procedures, especially in cases where sufficient amount of bone is not initially available. Bone augmentation procedures including harvesting bone from a secondary operating site can be painful - psychologically and physically.

John Orloff will present cases, with a comprehensive procedure of creating bone for implant placement using orthodontic movement of teeth into compromised implant sites and creating sufficient adjacent bone for esthetic implant insertion to provide the ideal foundation for a perfect ceramic esthetic result - the most comprehensive minimally invasive bone augmentation procedure.
